Here at St. Denis, it is my goal to have a whole host of altar boys, who regularly assist at Holy Mass each weekend. For this to take place, it is necessary to purchase some new cassocks and surplices; as the old ones are torn, tattered, and stained. Since altar boys range in age and size, it is necessary to have approximate 15-20 sets on hand. The cost for a cassock and surplice pairing is approximately \$150.00 each. #### FINANCIAL UPDATE

I would like to give you another brief financial update (a more comprehensive update to come in July). In the last update, I let you know that our total debt as of January 20 was \$171,508.08. As of April 18, we were able to pay off \$54,965.97 towards our outstanding debt, leaving us with a balance of \$116,542.11.

As of today, with your great generosity, smart savings, and God's grace we have managed to pay another \$8,800.53 towards our debt (for a total of \$63,766.50 over four months); leaving us with a balance of \$107,741.58, which I am confident we will be able to eliminate in the coming months/year.

Thank you for your continued commitment to our parish. We are truly blessed to have many parishioners (and visitors) who have given of their time, their talents, and their treasures in building up our parish community. We must always remember these four principles with regards to stewardship and ministry: Cheerfulness, Generosity, Gratitude, and Intentionality. Again, thank you for your commitment to parish life here at St. Denis.


